

Sanctions Policy MIGS® / Polyfuze™ Polymer Fusion Label Technology

Purpose

The United States Government prohibits engaging in or supporting sanctionable activities. As a U.S.-based company bound by U.S. laws, Joram Corp., dba Mold In Graphic Systems® / Polyfuze™ Graphics Corporation ("Company"), must comply with all applicable U.S. sanctions laws and regulations (as outlined in various legal statutes including the Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) regulations).

Summary of U.S. Government Policy of Prohibiting Trafficking in Persons

U.S. Government policy prohibits engaging in transactions or activities that are subject to U.S. economic sanctions. Government contractors, their employees, subcontractors, subcontractor employees, and agents must not engage in any practice that violates these sanctions. This includes, but is not limited to, the following activities:

- Engaging in any form of transaction or dealing with individuals, companies, or countries that are targeted by U.S. sanctions.
- Facilitating the transfer of goods, services, technology, or funds to sanctioned entities or countries.
- Engaging in any form of transaction that evades or avoids, attempts to violate, conspires to violate, or causes a violation of any U.S. sanctions.
- Failing to block or report transactions or assets where blocking and reporting are required by the U.S. Treasury.
- Using misleading or fraudulent practices to conceal involvement in sanctionable activities or to circumvent the requirements of U.S. sanctions laws.
- Engaging in any transactions involving blocked persons or property, unless authorized by a valid license or exemption.
- Ignoring or bypassing internal compliance programs designed to monitor and prevent violations of U.S. economic sanctions.

The Company is bound by U.S. laws, including those governing international trade and economic sanctions.
